FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will AWW NSW fund the transport for members to attend in person?

We will fund the transport for Sydney based members with limited mobility to attend the service. We can either send you a voucher or arrange community transport for you. To access the transport please call Diana on (02) 9267 6577.

Will there be food available?

A light morning tea and beverages will be offered.

What do I do with the Cross?

Instructions about what to do with your cross will be provided with your copy of The Digest in April. You might choose to leave it blank, write your loved one's name on it or their service number. You might choose to decorate it with a poppy or a heart or write a message on it to them. It is up to you to choose how you might like to use it to commemorate the service and sacrifices of your family.

Why is it different this year?

Due to the potential risks posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, we have adapted our plans to ensure the event is as safe as possible for all of those attending. This event will occur outdoors which limits COVID-19 risks. Also, we felt it was important to ensure that the plan for the Field of Remembrance is as COVID resilient as possible. By this we mean the service will go ahead this year, should an outbreak occur, all members can still participate at home. The only affect would be a cancellation of the in-person attendance.

Will this be a COVID safe event?

Yes, we are working with the Kokoda Track Memorial Walkway to ensure that the event is held safely and inline with all NSW Government requirements. It is strongly recommended that face masks be worn during your transport to and from the event if you are not using your own transport. You will need to check in on arrival and ensure you maintain social distancing.

What time does it start?

The service commences at 10.30 am. All guests should be seated by 10.25am. Please allow time to check in and register prior to the commencement of the Service.
